Flotation, urethane foam used throughout. Exceeds Coast Guard specs 3" draft. Blind, corduroy nylon with grass straps, nylon zippers in rear and sides. Adjustable and positive locking metal frame for raising blind. New carb, tuned motor, new battery and new tires on trailer. Ready for the season.

A camouflaged pop-up cordura blind with grassing straps is supplied with each boat. It allows easy access to the motor and allows either side to be dropped for gunning or as an entrance for hunters and dogs.

Powered by up to a 20 H.P. motor, the Canvasback can get from the boat launch to where the ducks are in rapid fashion and in complete comfort and safety.

SPECIFICATIONS

Material - fiberglass with foam core hull

Length - 14'

Width - 5'4"

Cockpit Opening - 7'6" x 3' with a 25" depth

* Front Storage Area (with dog bench) *

L 4' x W 4'4" x H 2' approx.

* Gunning Shelves - 7'3" located under the side decking *
for protection from the elements.

Rear Storage Area - W 20" x L 19" x H 15".

Running Lights - black non glare front and rear.

Cleats - black non glare front and rear.

Flotation - Urethane foam used throughout (no air tanks to leak) vastly exceeds Coast Guard specs.

Finish - textured pebble to minimize glare.

Hull - designed with a reinforced inverted V bow that sweeps back to a hard chine flat bottom with rear keel.

Drafts - Approx. 3" fully loaded with 2 hunters, dog, guns and 4 to 6 dozen decoys.

Blind - cordura nylon with grassing straps, nylon zippers in the rear and both sides, instantly adjustable and positive locking metal frame.
